- The Earth goes round the sun.

They eat

He/she/it
eats

Negative

I don't eat
You don't eat
We don't eat
They don't eat

He/she/it
doesn't eat

Interrogative

Do I eat?
Do You eat?
Do We eat?
Do They eat?

Does He/she/it
eat?
