

Singular and Plural Possessive Nouns

To show possession for a **singular noun**, an apostrophe is added **before the s**.

The **dog's** bed



To show possession for a **plural noun**, an apostrophe is added **after the s**.

The **dogs'** bed



Irregular plurals:
add the apostrophe
before the s.

The **children's** bed.

The **mice's** house.
