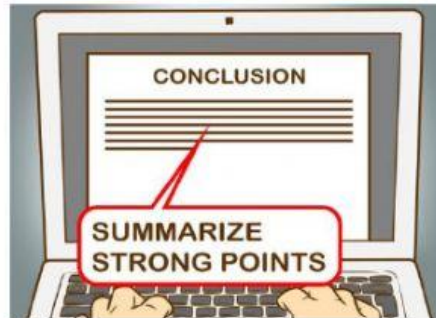


Organizing Your Report!

Conclusion: This is the end!

You have written a long report. Make sure the people reading it remember your most important points!

First, **restate your main idea** about your topic. Yes, you are writing your topic sentence again, but you are using different words to say it. Write your restated topic sentence in the Conclusion organizer below.



summarize = say something again, but using the **fewest words** possible

Second, think about your **3 Big Ideas**. They are your most important ideas, right? Put them in **one long sentence**. Here is an example, “I was confused when I graduated from college, but I found a great job and learned to manage my own home.”

Here is one possible sentence frame for you to use. If it doesn’t work for you, make up your own! What is important is that you include all 3 Big Ideas.
