Use **Be going to** for

- future plans

I'm **going to** wash the car today.

- intentions

We're **going to** eat outside.

- predictions based on present evidence

Look at that boy. He's **going to** fall off the ladder.

**\_\_\_\_\_** Jessie be back soon? I need to talk to her.

I hope I **\_\_\_\_\_** be happy when I grow up.

I **\_\_\_\_\_** eat more sweets before dinner. I promise.

Mum bought eggs, flour and fruit. She **\_\_\_\_\_** bake a cake.

Next year my sister **\_\_\_\_\_** learn how to drive a car.

We **\_\_\_\_\_** meet our cousins tonight.

**\_\_\_\_\_** you lend me a pen? I've got nothing to write with.

I **\_\_\_\_\_** call Liz as soon as I'm back.
