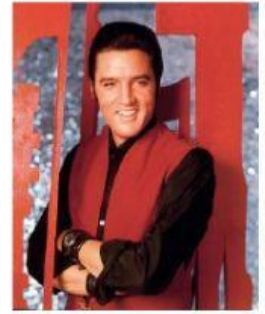


The King of Rock and Roll

Elvis ___(to be) a millionaire, but he ___(to be) a very lonely man. In his last years he ___(to become) fat and depressed. He ___(to die) of a heart attack on 16 August 1977 in his mansion at Graceland, Memphis.

But for his millions of fans, Elvis is still the King. Share Lyons has got more than 250 albums by Elvis and videos of all his films. 'Man, he was great,' says Shane. 'Elvis could really sing. Not like these kids today with all their electronic machines. He was the King, man, the King of Rock and Roll.'
