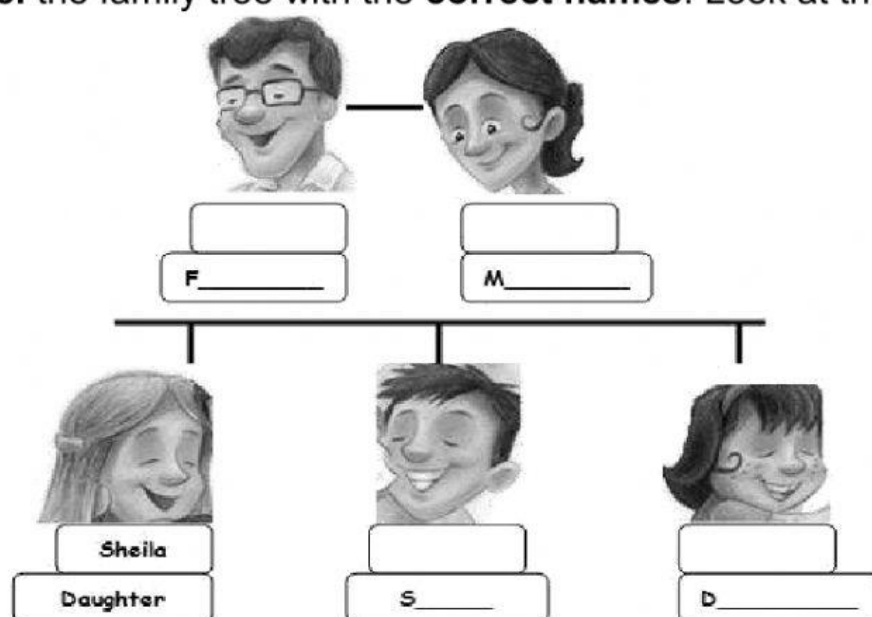
My father has got a brother. His name is Brian Jordan. He is my **uncle**.
