Imperative and Exclamatory Sentences



An **imperative sentence** gives a command. It tells you to do or not to do something. It ends with a period (.). Examples:

1. Wash your hands before you eat.
2. Don't take off your mask in a public place.

An **exclamatory sentence** expresses strong feelings. It ends with an exclamation mark (!). Examples:

1. What an inconvenience this Corona Virus is!
2. How careless it is to go to school if you are sick!
