REMEMBER HOW THE PASSIVE VOICE IS FORMED → **to be + past participle (3° col.)**

SIMPLE PRESENT: **am - is - are + past participle (3° col.)**

PRESENT PERFECT: **have – has + been + past participle (3° col.)**

SIMPLE PAST: **was - were + past participle (3° col.)**

SIMPLE FUTURE: **will be + past participle (3° col.)**
