Usos de "be going to"

1. Utilizamos esta forma para hablar de **planes e intenciones para el futuro**.

Por ejemplo, si he previsto con mis amigos jugar fútbol el próximo sábado, entonces puedo decir que la acción "jugar fútbol" es un **plan**; por lo tanto, digo lo siguiente en inglés:

I am going to play football with my friends on Saturday.

(Voy a jugar fútbol con mis amigos el sábado)

going to: future (affirmative & negative)			
I	'm / 'm not		go surfing.
He / She	's / isn't	going to	swim in the sea.
You / We / They	're / aren't		play football.

going to: future (questions)			
Am	I		
Is	he / she	going to	be rich?
Are	you / we / they		play tennis?

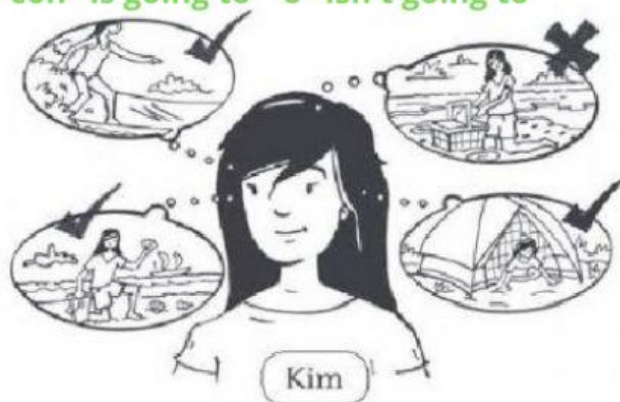
going to: future (short answers)

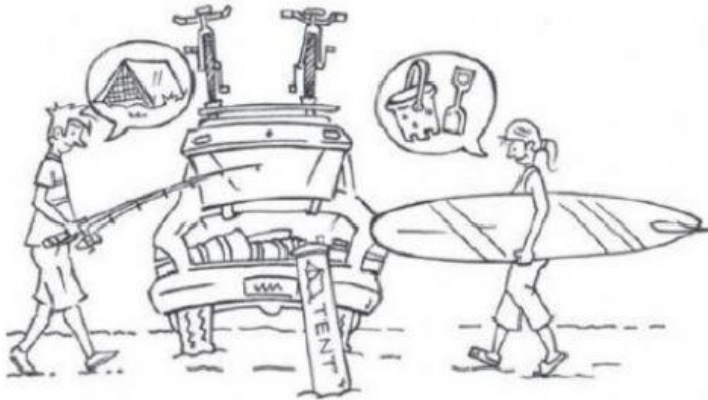
