

"SUCH/SO" "TOO/ENOUGH" SENTENCE TRANSFORMATIONS

Guidelines:

We use "such" with nouns (such a nice boy) and "so" with adjectives (that boy is so nice.)

We use "too" to denote excessiveness in adjectives (That cake is too sweet - I can't eat it.)

We use "not / enough" to denote insufficiency in adjectives (The coffee is not hot enough). Note that the adjective goes between the "not" and "enough".

When you are doing "too/enough" sentence transformations, be aware of antonyms. (He is too short. He is not tall enough.)
