Collecting rocks and minerals was fashionable 17.1. _____ the eighteenth century and was an important element in the ongoing debate 17.2. _____ the age and formation of the earth. The Orange Prize for Fiction honours 18.1. _____ women writers – but in these days of supposed equality, is 18.2. _____ still a need for a single sex award? The Orange Prize was founded when no female writers made the shortlist for the prestigious Booker Prize in 1991. In its 33-year history the Booker has honoured 12 female authors 18.3. _____ Iris Murdoch, Anita Brookner and Arundhati Roy. And one of the UK's 18.4. _____ major literature prizes, the Whitbread, has only given two women the top prize since 1985. The Nobel Prize 18.5. _____ Literature has seen just nine women receive the honour in 18.6. _____ 103-year history, the last 18.7. _____ Polish author writer Wisława Szymborska in 1996. So 18.8. _____ much discussion and hand-wringing in the publishing world it was decided that a women-only prize was necessary, 18.9. _____ be judged by female peers. Orange Prize co-founder and honorary director Kate Mosse said that in the year women were omitted 18.10. _____ the Booker shortlist there was much consternation from both sexes. It was felt some outstanding writing had been overlooked. "We thought that 18.11. _____ the fact that women published a great deal of fiction, and the majority of consumers and library lenders are women, the genre was being under-represented," said Ms Mosse.
