

CAUSE AND CONSEQUENCE

Because expresses cause and is followed by a subject and a verb

- *I study because I want to be a nurse.*

Because of expresses cause and is followed by a noun or a gerund

- *The roof was damaged because of the rain*

Since / as / due to the fact that express consequence and are followed by a subject and a verb

- *I didn't go to the beach since / as / due to the fact that it was raining.*

So expresses consequence and is followed by a subject and a verb.

- *I didn't have money, so I couldn't go to the trip*

Therefore / Consequently / As a result / For this reason express consequence and normally go at the beginning of a sentence, after a stop, and followed by a comma

- *I don't like pasta. Therefore, I never go to Italian restaurants.*
