1. Used when comparing two different or opposite facts or ideas:  
E.g. Gary, \_\_\_\_\_, used to be very thin.

2. Used when you are adding something, especially something surprising, to emphasize what you have just said:

E.g. \_\_\_\_\_, it's cheaper to fly than it is to drive.

3. To decide which one of a number of things, possibilities, people etc. that you want, because it is the best or most appropriate:

4. Used to introduce a statement that makes another statement seem surprising:
