

The imperative verbs

The use: We use the Imperative verb to give instructions, commands or advice.

*Affirmative sentence:

The structure (rule): The base form of the main verb, which is used without a subject + com.

e.g1: **Open** your books.

e.g2: **Be** careful!

*Negative sentence (Neg):

The structure: Don't+ the base form of the main verb, which is used without a subject +com.

e.g1: **Don't open** your books.

e.g. 2: **Don't play** here.

- 2- this tree. (not/to cut)
- 3- your father to fix the car. (to help)

* Exercise 2: Correct the mistakes in the following sentences:
