- Why are you checking the smell of the food?

3. She's **tasting** the soup.

- She is testing the flavour of the soup.
- The flavour of the soup is good.

4. It **feels** like velvet.

- Someone is touching the material.
- It has the texture of velvet

5. He's **having** a shower.

- He owns a shower.
- He's washing himself in the shower.

6. How are they **liking** the party?

- Parties are nice - generally?
- Are they enjoying the party?

7. I'm **thinking** about his suggestion.

- I believe in his suggestion.
- I'm considering his suggestion.

8. Tom **is being** very impolite.

- Tom is an impolite person.
- Tom is behaving impolitely.

9. It **looks** like it's going to rain.

- It appears
- It is viewing the sky.

10. The nurse is **weighing** the baby.

- The baby weighs 2 kilos.
- The nurse is checking how much the baby weighs.
