


UNSEEN — READ THE TEXT AND ANSWER THE QUESTIONS

Meet Jason Thomas

On the morning of September 11, 2001, two planes crashed into the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City. When Jason Thomas heard the news of the terrorist attack, he

- 5 immediately drove into the city. He arrived just after the second building fell. Most people were running away, but Thomas, a former marine officer*, ran towards the buildings. He knew this was an emergency situation. He later said:
- 10 "Someone needed help. It didn't matter who. I didn't even have a plan. But I have all this training* as a marine and all I could think was, 'My city is in need.'"

Thomas offered his help. He fought fires and he helped survivors in any way he could.


- 15 After hours of work, Thomas met another former marine, Dave Karnes. They made a plan to look for people who might still be alive and to try to rescue them. Other soldiers told them that their plan was too dangerous and refused to help. Thomas and Karnes made a decision to go by themselves.

- The two of them climbed the mountain of the fallen buildings with only flashlights and a
20 shovel, shouting out, "Is anyone down there? United States Marines!" Time passed, but finally they heard a reply. They went into a deep hole and found two police officers, hurt but alive. It was a miracle.

- Thomas returned to Ground Zero* every day for over two weeks to help out. He never gave his full name, only Sergeant* Thomas, and he never told his wife and children about
25 the rescue.

- Five years later, Thomas, who had moved from New York to Ohio, saw an ad on TV for a movie called *World Trade Center*. It showed two marines with flashlights, looking for survivors at Ground Zero. The filmmakers, unable to find Thomas when they made the movie,
30 were very happy when he called them. They had finally found the man behind the scenes!
