

## REVISION OF TENSE

<i>Simple Present</i>	<i>Base form of the verb</i>
<i>Example: I read a book. He reads a book.</i>	
<i>Present Continuous</i>	<i>Is/am/are + Ving</i>
<i>Example: He is reading a book.</i>	
<i>Simple Past</i>	<i>Past form of the verb</i>
<i>Example: He repaired the roof.</i>	
<i>Past Continuous</i>	<i>Was/were + Ving</i>
<i>Example: He was reading a book.</i>	
<i>Simple Future</i>	<i>Will /Shall+ base verb</i>
<i>Example: He will read a book.</i>	
<i>Future Continuous</i>	<i>Will/shall + be + Ving</i>
<i>Example: He will be reading a book.</i>
