I	→	MYSELF
YOU	→	YOURSELF
HE	→	HIMSELF
SHE	→	HERSELF
IT	→	ITSELF
WE	→	OURSELVES
YOU	→	YOURSELVES
THEY	→	THEMSELVES



REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS ARE USED WHEN THE **OBJECT** OF THE SENTENCE IS THE **SAME** AS THE **SUBJECT**.

(I CUT MYSELF WITH THE KNIFE)
THEY ARE ALSO USED TO EMPHASIZE THAT THE SUBJECT DID SOMETHING **WITHOUT HELP**.

(I DID THE HOMEWORK MYSELF)
