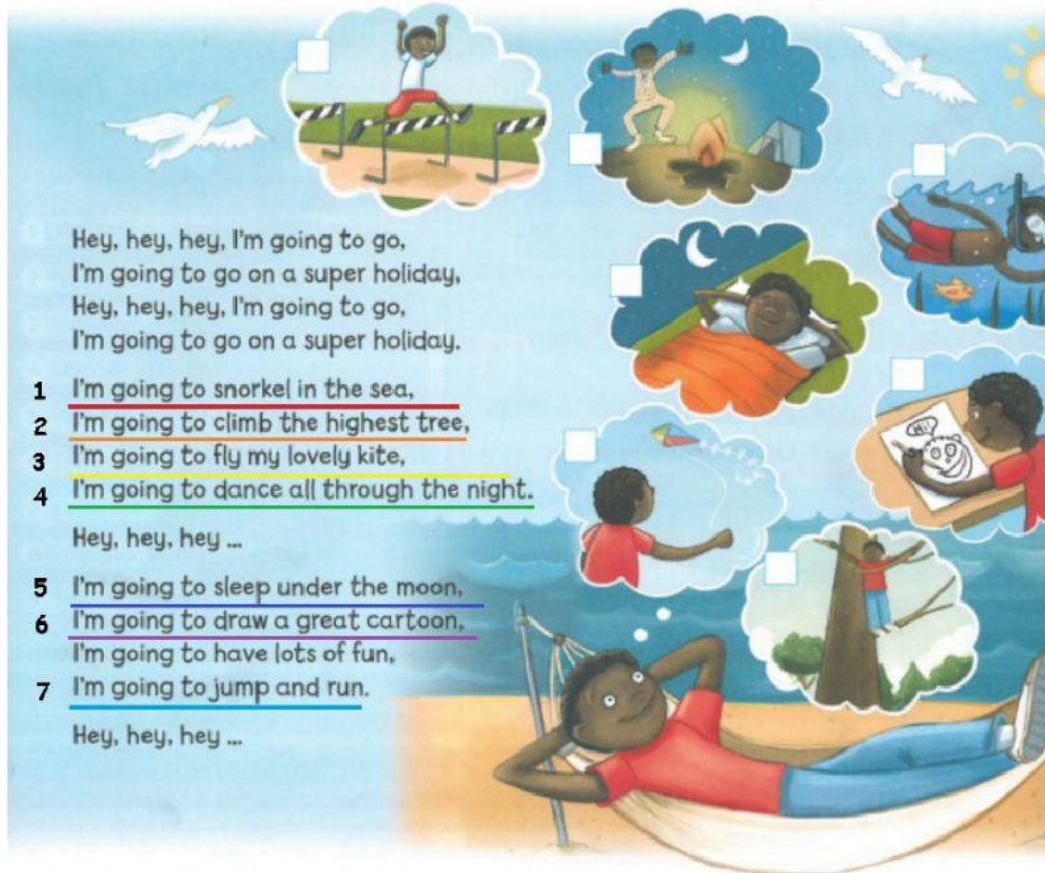


Reading and Vocabulary: What are you going to do?
