Present Perfect Continuous

(have/has been +verb + ing)

An action that started in the past, and continued up until the present

She for the last 2 hours. (read)

He under the desk for the last hour. (sit)

He on the phone since he got here. (talk)

They the wrong medication for years. (take)

Joe here since 1987. (work)

Mary since 10 o'clock this morning. (swim)

You nothing for the past hour! (do)

We all day. (sunbathe)

To show something was happening lately or recently

• I better lately. (feel)

He difficulty with his schoolwork. (have)

She a lot recently. (study)

• We a bit down lately. (feel)

Recently, he all the wrong foods. (eat)

• Lately, I much more frequently. (exercise)

These days you far too much! (daydream)
