Past Continuous Tense

Was/were + verb + -ing

Actions that were in progress at a certain point or at a certain time period in the past.

• He all day. (fly)

Last night at 8 o'clock we . (dance)

At 1pm today we coffee. (have)

Annoying repeating actions in the past.

They always me to do all the work. (leave)

He always on duty. (sleep)

He always while he worked. (whistle)

A past action was in progress when another action interrupted it.

While Julie the dishes, the phone rang. (wash)

• I football, when I broke my ankle. (play)

They when the alarm went off. (sleep)

He when the accident happened. (drive)

He when he stumbled and fell. (walk)

Two or more actions which were happening simultaneously (at the same time) in the past.

• She (cook) while the baby (sleep)

• He (play) golf while she (read)

• They (play) while their mother (work)
