




The temperature is warm, around 17 degrees. In Wales, it's raining and the temperature is around 15 degrees. In Newcastle and Scotland, it's an awful weather today: it's freezing, windy and snowing! Temperature is around minus 4 degrees. Be careful and don't forget your pullover!
