Simple Future

(will + verb)

Note: we don't usually use "will" to talk about future plans.

To talk about future plans we use "going to" or the Present Continuous.

For example:

Tomorrow morning, we are **going to** visit grandma. or

Tomorrow morning we are visiting grandma. (Present Continuous.)

Future actions or future states (not plans)

Next week she
 5 years old. (be)

• The coffee soon. (cool)

• I the kettle on for tea. (put)

He his exams easily. (pass)

Promises, intentions, hopes, fears, predictions.

• I my room later. (clean)

• I this game. (win)

• I you clean the house later. (help)

I hope he his birthday present. (like)

• I think it later today. (rain)

I the money you lent me by tomorrow. (repay)

• They very soon. (arrive)

• I you with me next week. (take)

• She is very ill. I hope she better by tomorrow. (be)

• I think she if I don't remind her. (forget)

By the time you arrive we finished our meal. (have)
