

Simple Future

(will + verb)

Note: we don't usually use "will" to talk about future plans.

To talk about future plans we use "**going to**" or the **Present Continuous**.

For example:

Tomorrow morning, we are **going to** visit grandma.

or

Tomorrow morning we **are visiting** grandma. (**Present Continuous**.)

Future actions or future states (not plans)

- Next week she 5 years old. (be)
- The coffee soon. (cool)
- I the kettle on for tea. (put)
- He his exams easily. (pass)

Promises, intentions, hopes, fears, predictions.

- I my room later. (clean)
- I this game. (win)
- I you clean the house later. (help)
- I hope he his birthday present. (like)
- I think it later today. (rain)
- I the money you lent me by tomorrow. (repay)
- They very soon. (arrive)
- I you with me next week. (take)
- She is very ill. I hope she better by tomorrow. (be)
- I think she if I don't remind her. (forget)
- By the time you arrive we finished our meal. (have)
