

### First and Third Conditionals – (a) = 1<sup>st</sup> & (b) = 3<sup>rd</sup> Conditional

1. a) If we (to win) a trip to Cape Town, we (to be) able to go.  
b) If we (win) a trip to Cape Town, we (be) able to go.
2. a) If we (to hurry), we (not/miss) our flight.  
b) If we (hurry), we (not miss) our flight.
3. a) If our flight (to be) delayed, we (arrive) there late.  
b) If our flight (be) delayed, we (arrive) there late.
4. a) If they (to lose) our luggage, we (have) to buy more clothes.  
b) If they (lose) our luggage, we (have) to buy more clothes.
5. a) If I (to lose) my boarding pass, I (not be) able to board.  
b) If I (lose) my boarding pass, I (not be) able to board.
6. a) If I (to be) cold on the flight, I (ask) the flight attendant for a blanket.  
b) If I (be) cold on the flight, I (ask) the flight attendant for a blanket.
7. a) If it (to be) warm in Cape Town, we (swim)  
b) If it (be) warm in Cape Town, we (swim).
8. a) If I (to be) sick on the flight, I (call) the flight attendant.  
b) If I (be) sick on the flight, I (call) the flight attendant.
