- 8) Do you know the reason for her being so upset? WHY  
Do you know.....upset?
- 9) Dennis is saving money. He wants to go to Australia. IN  
Dennis is saving money.....to Australia.
- 10) She started an art and design course last year. She plans to open her own business.  
VIEW  
She started an art and design course last year.....her own business.
- 11) You can say what you like but I don't think he'll win. MATTER  
No....., I don't think he'll win.
- 12) You can come with me if you promise to behave yourself. PROVIDED  
You can come with me.....to behave yourself.
- 13) I didn't tell him what I thought because I didn't want to upset him. SO  
I didn't tell him what I thought.....him.
- 14) Take some sandwiches. There may not be a café at the station. IN  
Take some sandwiches.....a café at the station.
- 15) James has decided to buy a motorbike; we can't stop him. PREVENT  
We can't.....a motorbike.
