YET

- To ask if something expected has happened.
 - Have the test results arrived yet?
 - I'm hungry. Is dinner already yet?
- To say something expected hasn't happened.
 - I haven't done my homework yet.
 - It's almost 11 o'clock and John hasn't woken up yet.

ALREADY

An action has happened sooner than expected.

- I have just finished lunch but I'm already hungry.
- I think Mary already knows about the surprise party.

Already

Yet

He hasn't done his homework yet.*
