## SOME. A

We use A or AN with singular nouns. A is used when a noun starts with a consonant sound:

e.g. A dog, a book, etc. AN is used when a noun starts with a vowel sound;

e.g. An apple, an bour, etc.

We use **SOME** with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns.

**SOME** is used in:

\* positive sentences;

e.g. I have got some time.

\* questions, expressing requests and offers;

E.g. Would you like some tea?

Can I have some biscuits?

We use ANY with countable nouns (only with their plural) and with uncountable nouns. ANY is used in:

\* negative sentences;

e.g. I baven't got any time.

\* general questions;

e.g. Have you got any sisters? Is there any tea left?
