Quoc Hoc Hue (Hue National School), which is situated near Trang Tien Bridge of Hue city, is one of the most prestigious high school in Vietnam. It was founded in 1896 so as to train those who would serve the feudal colonial government, so French was the main subject in the curriculum. Established under the reign of

Thanh Thai King, it was named Ecole Primaire Supérieur but also called Quoc Hoc, Khai Dinh High School (1936-1954), Ngo Dinh Diem High School (1955-1956) then Quoc Hoc since 1956 until now.

Not only is Quoc Hoc well known for its stunning landscapes, it also gains prominence for tradition of patriotism, industriousness and academic achievements. For a long time, Quoc Hoc has always been ranked in the top three high schools in the nation in terms of the quality of education since the academic year 1994-1995. The other schools include Chu Van An High School in Hanoi and Le Hong Phong High School in Ho Chi Minh City. The school is also famous for the notable political leaders such as General Vo Nguyen Giap, Prime Minister Pham Van Dong who graduated from it and President Ho Chi Minh who was dismissed from it in 1908 for revolutionary activities.

Quoc hoc Hue is a major tourist attraction which attracts many visitors at home and abroad every year. This is the place for those who want to take photos of natural background, understand more about French colonial architecture and watch female students in white "Ao dai", sparkling in the nice background.
