Mum: We're nearly packed. Let me just check what you need to get from the shop. We've got toothpaste but could you get me a new toothbrush?

Girl: OK. I also need one, so I'll get two and some shampoo.

Mum: There's a new bottle upstairs.

Girl: We'll take that then. I can't think of anything else.

The first picture is correct so there is a tick in box A.
