David **(love)** his grandparents a lot because they **(always make)** him little presents and they **(not be)** angry with him. Only Dagobert, the dog, **(not be)** happy whenever the older couple **(spend)** a weekend with them because grandma **(be)** allergic to pet hair and Dagobert **(not can)** stay in the house but he **(must)** stay in the garden and garden shed instead.
