Por ejemplo:



I CAN speak English quite well. = Yo sé hablar inglés bastante bien.

¿Qué expresamos con CAN'T? Con este verbo expresamos lo que NO podemos / NO sabemos hacer.

Por ejemplo:



I CAN'T speak Japanese.= Yo NO sé hablar japonés.
