Fantastic! You have written 1 paragraph for your Introduction and 3 paragraphs for your Body! You have 1 paragraph left: the ending or conclusion. Remember: an essay has at least 5 paragraphs:  $1+3+1 = 5$ .

**conclusion = ending that summarizes ideas and tells why they're important**

In the **conclusion**, you restate (say again) your topic and big ideas, then remind your reader why what you said is important. Here is an example:

Restate topic: Goldie's best strategy would be to murder Sugar.

Summarize (say all your Big Ideas in 1 sentence!): Sugar is a hateful person, she will always be in Goldie's life, and killing her would benefit Goldie.

State Importance: Sometimes murder is the best solution to a problem.
