



Writing: Explain how to do something.

Read the paragraph. Then, read each question and click on the correct answer.

Make a Guitar

(1) Glue four toothpicks on the lid. (2) Space the toothpicks evenly between the hole and the other end of the lid. (3) Cut a hole near one end of a shoe box lid. (4) Slide the two thickest rubber bands around the shoe box, so they go across the hole in the lid. (5) Finally, slide the two thinnest rubber bands around the box in the same way. (6) Then slide the pencil under the four rubber bands. (7) Move the pencil at the very end of the box near the hole you cut. (8) Now play the guitar by plucking the rubber bands.

1. What change, if any, should be made to sentences 2 and 3?

- A Move sentence 2 to the beginning of the paragraph.
