4. The pet store sold 3 435 fish for sale last month. This month, 2708 were sold. What is the sum of the fish that were sold last month and this month?

5. Carlos purchased 5 005 beans for his bean bag. His mother bought 3 296 beans for him. How many beans does Carlos have now?
