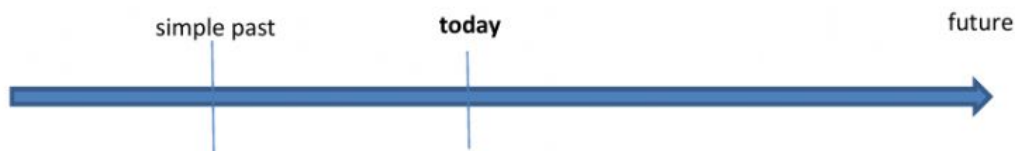




Simple Past

The simple past is used to talk about things that happened in the past and have no connection to the present.



1) There are signal **words** that tell you to use the simple past. Match the following signal words with their German translation.

2) regular verbs

infinitive + ed

I clean my room.



Yesterday, I **cleaned** my room.

Did you **clean** your room yesterday?

I **didn't** **clean** my room yesterday.

3) irregular verbs

Unfortunately, there is no trick to build the irregular verbs. You have to learn them!

Verb	Simple Past	Negation	Question
be	(I) was / (you) were	wasn't / weren't	Was I / Were you..?
become	became	didn't become	Did you become...?
begin	began	didn't begin	Did you begin...?
break	broke	didn't break	Did you break...?
bring	brought	didn't bring	Did you bring...?
buy	bought	didn't buy	Did you buy...?
come	came	didn't come	Did you come...?
do	did	didn't	Did you do...?
eat	ate	didn't eat	Did you eat...?
find	found	didn't find	Did you find...?
forget	forgot	didn't forget	Did you forget...?
go	went	didn't go	Did you go...?
give	gave	didn't give	Did you give ...?
have	had	hadn't	Did you have...?
say	said	didn't say	Did you say...?
tell	told	didn't tell	Did you tell...?
write	wrote	didn't write	Did you write...?
