1. Germs cause disease in living organisms.



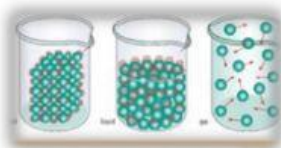
2. Gravity attracts every object in the universe to every other object. The attractive force can be calculated using the following formula: $F = G \frac{m_1 m_2}{r^2}$

5. All living things are made of microscopic cells.



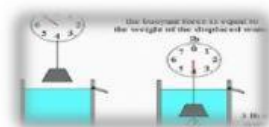
6. For every action, there is an equal and opposite reaction.



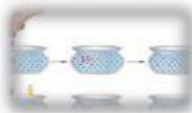
7. Light is responsible for color.
