- Always use the auxiliary used in the sentence, at the same tense.
- The question tag for I AM is AREN'T I
- There is always repeated (there is milk in the fridge, isn't there?)
- When there is no auxiliary in the sentence, use do at the right person and tense. (you like cheese, don't you/ She travelled by night, didn't she?)
