Past Simple	I did my homework.	My homework was done .	Future Be going to	I'm going to do my homework.	My homework is going to be done .
Past Continuous	I was doing my homework.	My homework was being done .	Modal	I must do my homework.	My homework must be done .
Present Perfect	I have done my homework.	My homework has been done .	Modal Perfect	I should have done my homework.	My homework should have been done .
