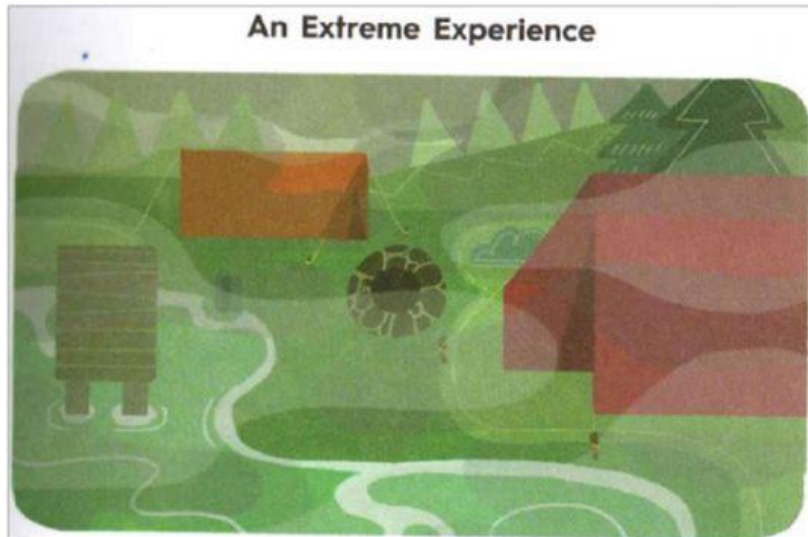


Reading Comprehension
