**Extract One**

You hear two colleagues discussing a conference on cyberbullying that they have just attended.

1. **What is the woman's main objection to the conference?**

2. **The woman criticises the man for**  
A being too optimistic about a possible solution.  
B setting a goal that would not be beneficial.  
C failing to use solutions that have worked in the past.

**Extract Two**

You overhear a man showing a woman a school photograph.

A The people in it have changed.  
B It is an accurate reflection of daily life at school.  
C He was uncomfortable while it was being taken.
4. **Looking back at his schooldays, the man**  
A feels he might like to go back to being a student.  
B appreciates having had a large number of friends.  
C questions the motives of people that were friendly to him.
5. **What does the woman's reply show?**  
A She identifies with the people he is criticising.  
B She feels that his suspicions are probably accurate.  
C She went through an experience similar to his at school.
