

Comprehension - CAUSE and EFFECT

Cause & Effect

Cause = The reason for something happening.

Effect = What happened.

Cause + Effect = Explains why things happen.

Cause and Effect

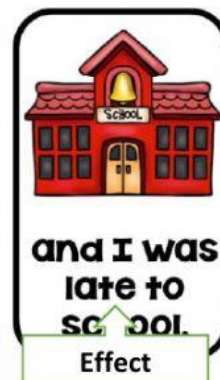
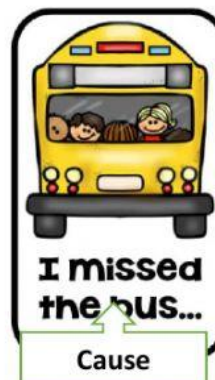
- The cause is the first thing that happens.
- It makes the second thing (the effect) happen.
- The part of the sentence after the word **because** is the cause.

Example:


I stayed home from school
because I had the flu.
