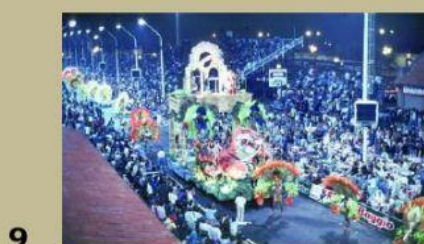
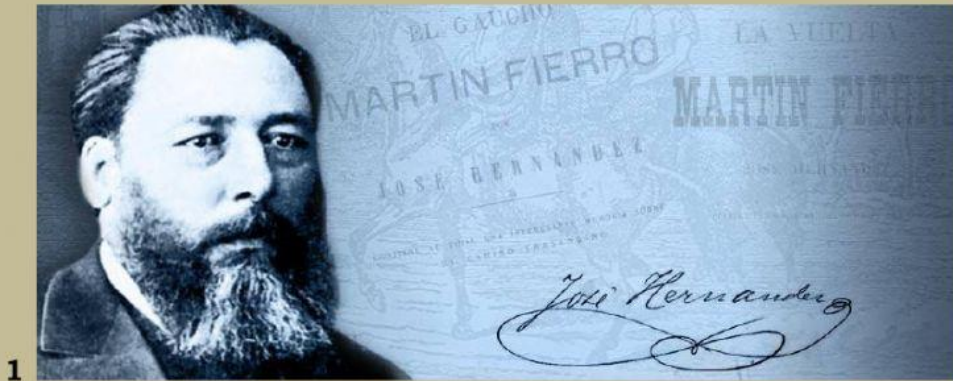
### A) TASK : MATCH QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS



1	When is Tradition Day celebrated in Argentina?	Jose Hernandez's Birthday.
2	Is it a holiday = feriado?	Some of them are: the gaucho lifestyle, the guitar, the "mate" = typical drink, the farm life, "peñas" = meetings, the folk = "folklore", the "asado" = barbecue, and more.
3	Whose birth does it commemorate?	We can drink "mate" at any time.. In the morning for breakfast, in the afternoon, with friends or alone; when we study, when we travel, anywhere... In times of covid19 it is advisable to have your own "mate".
4	Who was Jose Hernandez?	It's on November 10 <sup>th</sup> .
5	What is "Martin Fierro"?	It also shows many of the traditional customs of Argentina.
6	What happened to him?	He died on October 21 <sup>st</sup> , 1886 in Belgrano, BA, Argentina.
7	As regards Literature, what person (narrator) is it used in the writing?	He was taken to the border by the government to fight the aboriginal tribes.
8	What does the book show?	He was born on November 10, 1834.
9	What customs does it mention?	.. not always.. unfortunately
10	When do people drink "mate" in Argentina?	The book is written in first person narrative, sung by the gaucho himself with his guitar.
11	Where was Jose Hernandez born?	He was born in San Martin, BA, Argentina.
12	When was Jose Hernandez born?	He was a journalist, a poet, and a politician.
13	When did he die?	He is the author of the epic poem "Martin Fierro"
14	What was his profession?	He apparently wrote this masterpiece in Brazil, during his period of exile. It was later
15	Where did JH write the pinnacle of gauchesque literature?	It was published in two parts in 1872 and in 1879.
16	When was it published?	It's the story about the life of an Argentine gaucho .
