 - To form the **imperative**, use the *infinitive* form of the verb without "to."
 - To make a negative imperative, put "do not" or "don't" in front of the verb, as in, "**Don't touch** that!"

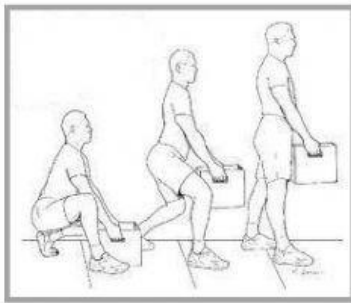
Accident:

_____ seek immediate first aid treatment

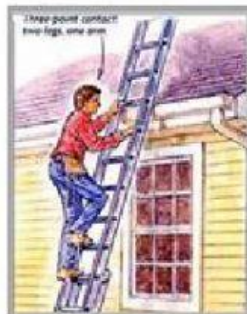
Chemical spill:
