

Both...and: to emphasize two people or things

- I love both swimming and riding.
- She both walks and listens to music.

Not only but also: to emphasize two people or things or ideas. However, the subject that follows not only is usually previously known. The latter expresses surprise, admiration, envy, or some other sentiment about the the combination.

- She not only reads books but also watches TV.
- We love not only swimming but also riding.

Either or: to emphasize that there is an alternative. It is also used in negative forms.

- We don't either go out or watch TV.
- We play either tennis or basketball.

Neither nor: to emphasize that two alternatives are not possible, likely or true

- She likes neither cigarette nor beer.
- We neither had dinner nor drank tea.
