Use to indicate the purpose of an action.

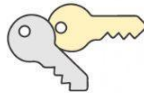


I use my camera **to take** pictures.

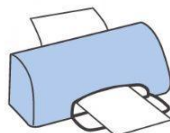
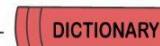
