They released their first single, "What Makes You Beautiful" in the UK in August 2011, and it became one of the fastest selling songs of the year, and went on to hit number one in the charts.

In February 2012, the song received a Brit Award for "Best British Single", and was also released in the USA & Canada. Since this they've won a huge amount of other awards.
