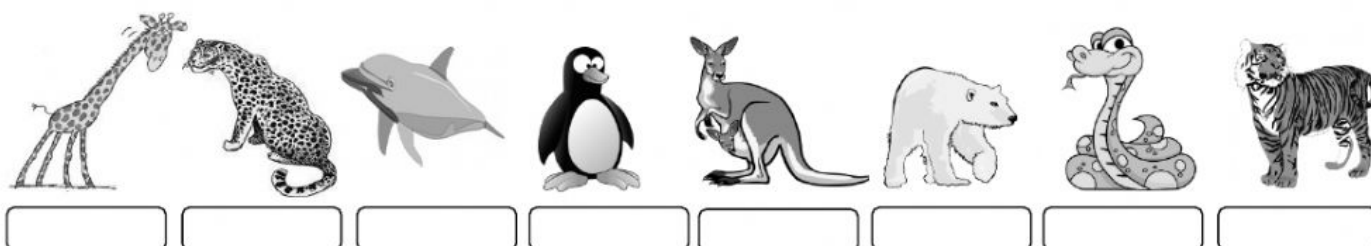

Marie Curie was a physicist and chemist. She was born in 1867 in Warsaw, Poland. She grew up there but girls couldn't go to university in Poland so she moved to France with her sister. She studied medicine at the University of Paris-Sorbonne. After she graduated, she also studied physics and math. She met Pierre Curie and they got married in 1895. They had two girls. She won the Nobel Prize in 1903 with Pierre Curie and Henri Becquerel for their researches on radiation. Her husband died in 1906. She won the Nobel Prize again in 1911 in chemistry because she discovered the elements radium and polonium. Radiation made her leukemia and died in 1934. Authorities call her "Woman who died for Science."
