Playground Games
Who is it?

When you play a game, you have to choose who starts, or who is "it." This can be a problem because sometimes everyone wants to be "it." Sometimes, no one wants to be "it." You can use a rhyme to decide. Here's how:

Each person makes two fists. One person says the rhyme and hits one fist for each word in the rhyme. (This person has to use his or her chin for their second fist). The person that you hit last must put that hand behind his or her back. People are out when they have two hands behind their backs. Repeat the rhyme until one person is left. That person is "it."
