Subject Pronouns	Object Pronouns	Subject – Object
I speak English.	Bob knows me .	I – me
You speak English.	Bob know you .	you – you
She speaks English.	Bob knows her .	she – her
He speaks English.	Bob knows him .	he – him
It starts at 8:00.	Bob knows it .	it – it
We speak English.	Bob talks to us .	we – us
You speak English	Bob talks to you .	you – you
They speak English.	Bob talks to them .	they – them
